1. Previously graduated from a Yakima County high school or received a homeschool certificate/diploma in Yakima County or received a Washington State GED high school equivalency certificate while a resident of Yakima County.
2. Currently enrolled in a college, university or trade school.
3. Completed at least 45 quarter hours or 30 semester hours.
4. Maintained at least of 2.5 grade point average.
5. Scholarship funds may be used for tuition, books, or lab fees.
6. If selected for a scholarship, the funds will be sent directedly to your school.
7. All application requirements must be postmarked or electronically dated by **July 12, 2024.**
