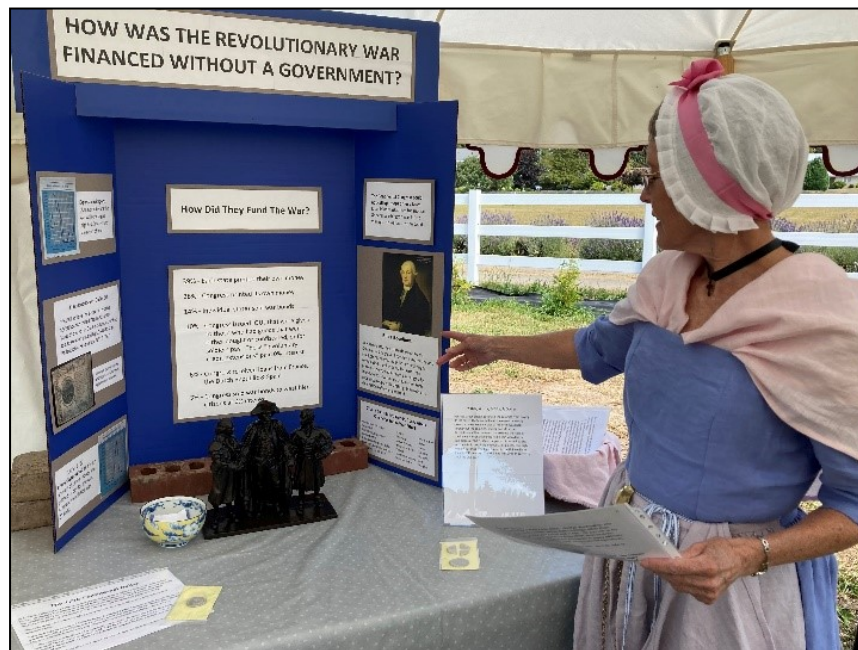

These blankets will be collected, boxed and mailed to new parent course graduates or related groups on military bases in Germany and other overseas locations.

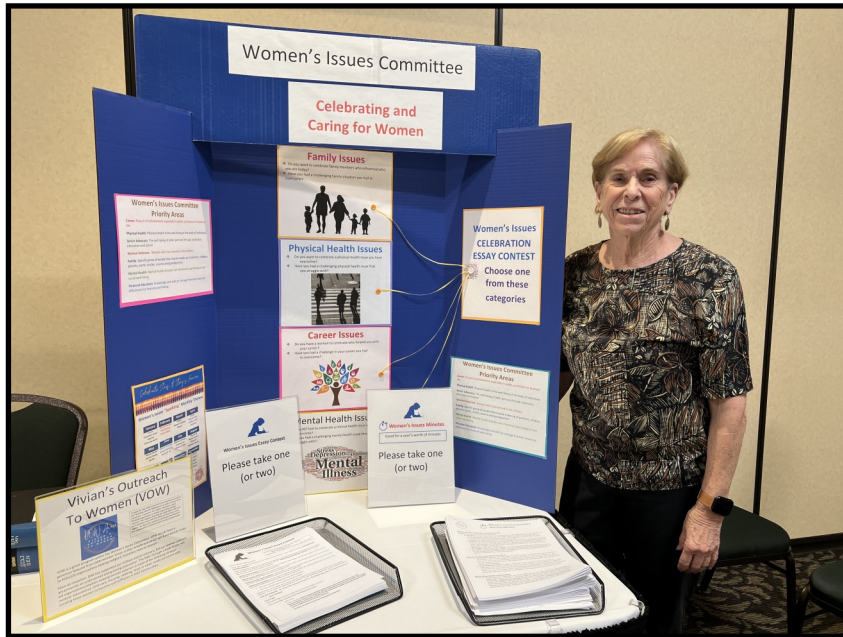
